#### Notes: Comparisons with reference to three months ended 31.12.2012

Net Sales have increased by 4.6%. "Net Domestic Sales" have increased by 3.7% mainly on account of net realisations and product mix. "Export Sales" grew by 20.9% contributed largely by export to affiliates.

### Comparisons are with reference to full year ended 2012

 "Net Domestic Sales" grew by 7.1% contributed by net realisations and volume growth in certain product categories. "Export Sales" grew by 47.1% mainly due to export to affiliates.

Total foreign currency earnings are equivalent to USD 83.6 millions (previous year USD 55.3 millions).

- 2. The increase in "Other Operating Income" is mainly due to higher realisation of export incentives.
- 3. "Other Income" improved largely due to higher average liquidities coupled with better yields during the latter part of the year.
- 4. "Depreciation and Amortization" has increased due to expansion in production capacities made over the last year together with amortization of capitalised borrowing costs and exchange differences partially offset by lower depreciation of certain plant and machinery that have not run on multiple shifts.
- 5. "Net Provision for Contingencies" is mainly for matters related to litigation in accordance with the Accounting Standard AS 29 on "Provisions, Contingent Liabilities and Contingent Assets".
- 6. "Tax Expense" has increased mainly due to the change in income-tax surcharge from 5% to 10% effective 01.04.2013.
- 7. Statement of Assets and Liabilities (comparison with the position as at 31.12.2012): -
  - "Long-term borrowings" have increased mainly due to restatement of outstanding ECB loan at the closing exchange rate. US Dollar (USD) 192 million continues to remain outstanding since April 2012 and its annualised cost over the loan period since inception, including interest and unrealised exchange differences, is 17.6%.
  - "Deferred tax liabilities (net)" have increased largely due to the incremental difference between tax and book depreciation as well as revaluation of net liabilities at the revised income tax rate.
  - "Long-term provisions" have increased due to provisions for employee retirement benefit and contingencies.
  - "Non-current investments" include investment in long term tax free bonds as well as acquisition of a non-controlling stake in "Sahyadri Agro And Dairy Limited" previously known as "Indocon Agro and Allied Activities Private Ltd."
  - "Short-term loans and advances" have increased mainly due to subscription money for tax free bonds pending allotment.
  - "Cash & Bank balances" and "Current Investments" have increased due to better cash flows from operations.
- 8. The Board of Directors has recommended a final dividend for 2013 of ₹ 12.50 per equity share (Face value ₹ 10/- per equity share). This is in addition to the two interim dividends of ₹ 18.00 each per equity share paid in August and November 2013 respectively. The total dividend per share in 2013 aggregates to ₹ 48.50 per equity share, the same as in the last four years which is in line with the financing strategy of the Company.
- As the Company's business activity falls within a single primary business segment, namely Food, the disclosure requirements of Clause 41 of the Listing Agreement in terms of Accounting Standard AS 17 on Segment Reporting are not applicable.
- 10. Figures of last quarter are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of the full year and the un-audited published figures upto the third quarter ended 30th September.
- 11. Previous period's figures have been regrouped / reclassified wherever necessary, to make them comparable with the current period.

- 1. We have audited the accompanying Statement of Financial Results of NESTLÉ INDIA LIMITED ("the Company") for the year ended 31/12/2013 ("the Statement"), being submitted by the Company pursuant to Clause 41 of the Listing Agreement with the Stock Exchange, except for the disclosures in Part II Select Information referred to in paragraph 5 below. This Statement has been prepared on the basis of the related annual financial statements, which are the responsibility of the Company's Management and have been approved by the Board of Directors. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on the Statement, based on our audit of the related annual financial statements, which have been prepared in accordance with the Accounting Standards notified under the Companies Act, 1956 (which continues to be applicable in respect of Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 in terms of General Circular 15/2013 dated 13 September 2013 of the Ministry of Corporate Affairs) and other accounting principles generally accepted in India.
